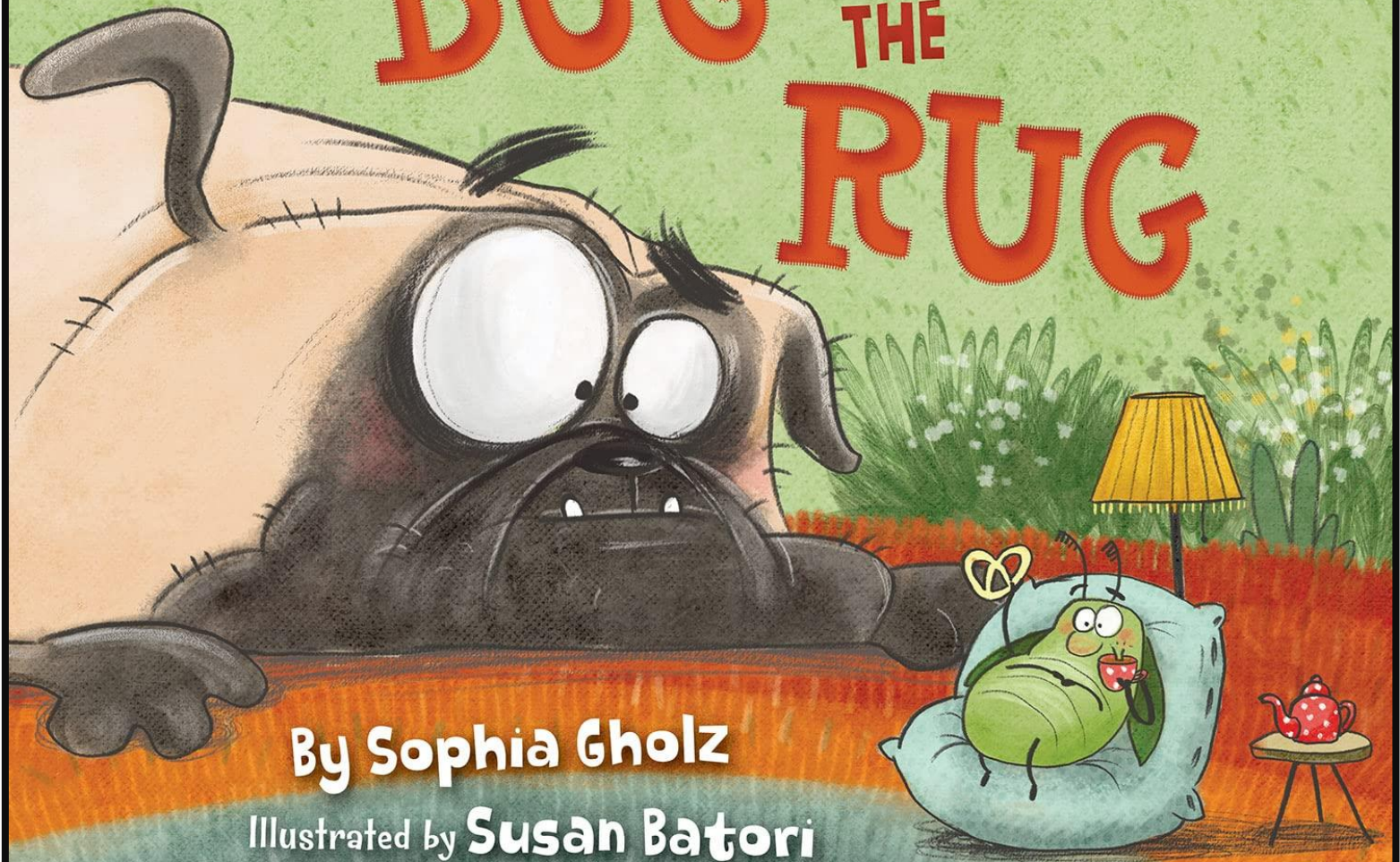

### WORD SEARCH

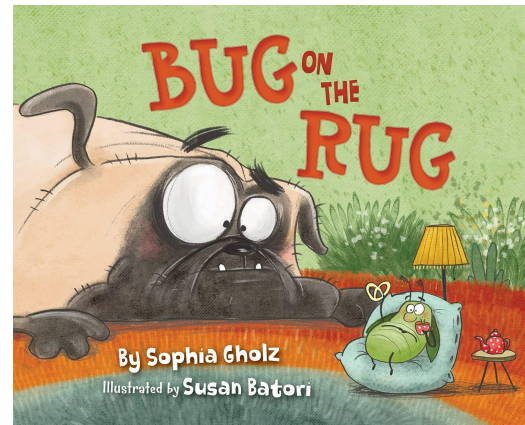
Copy word search pages on white copy paper. Provide pencils for young audience members to search and find the names of unique colors during your launch party or book signing event.

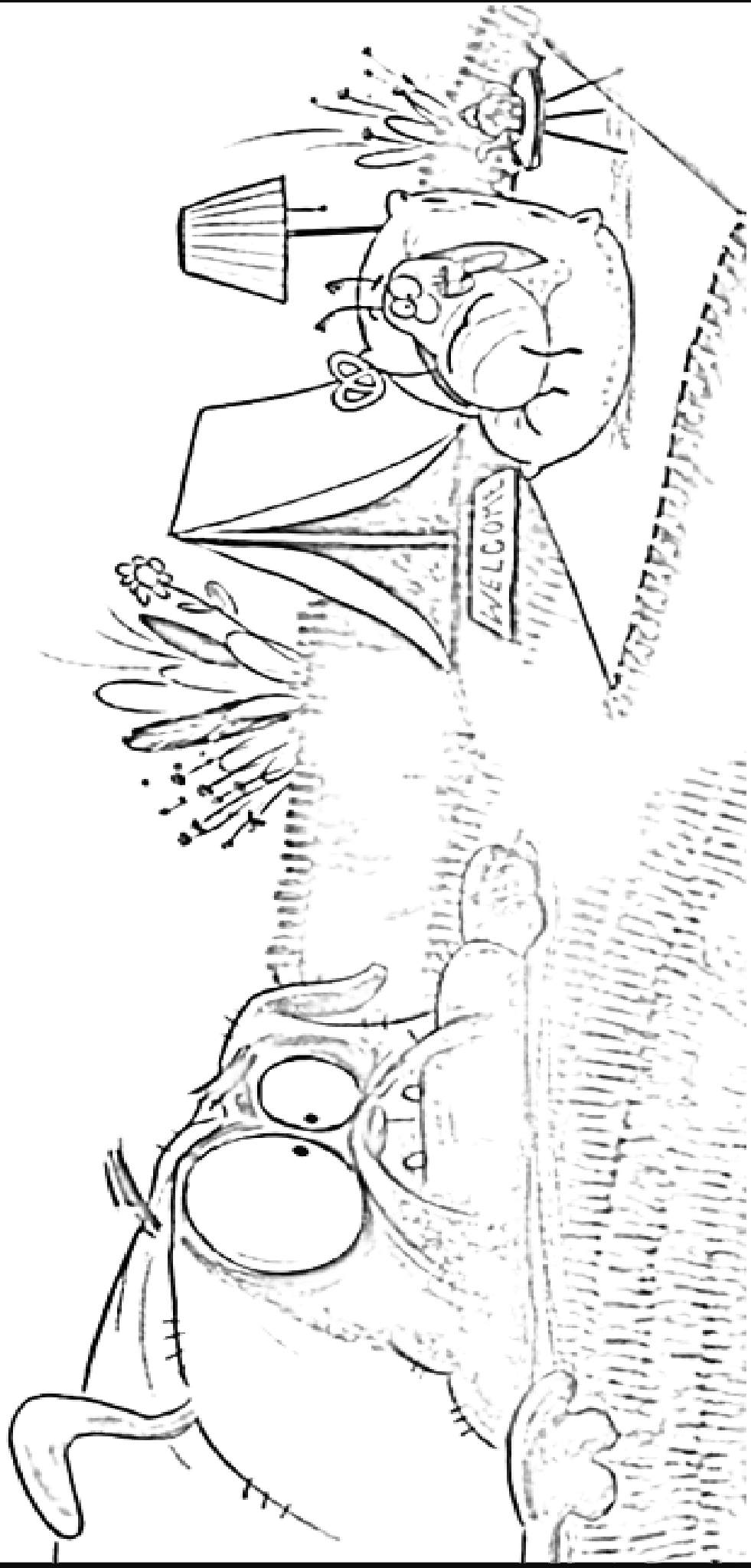

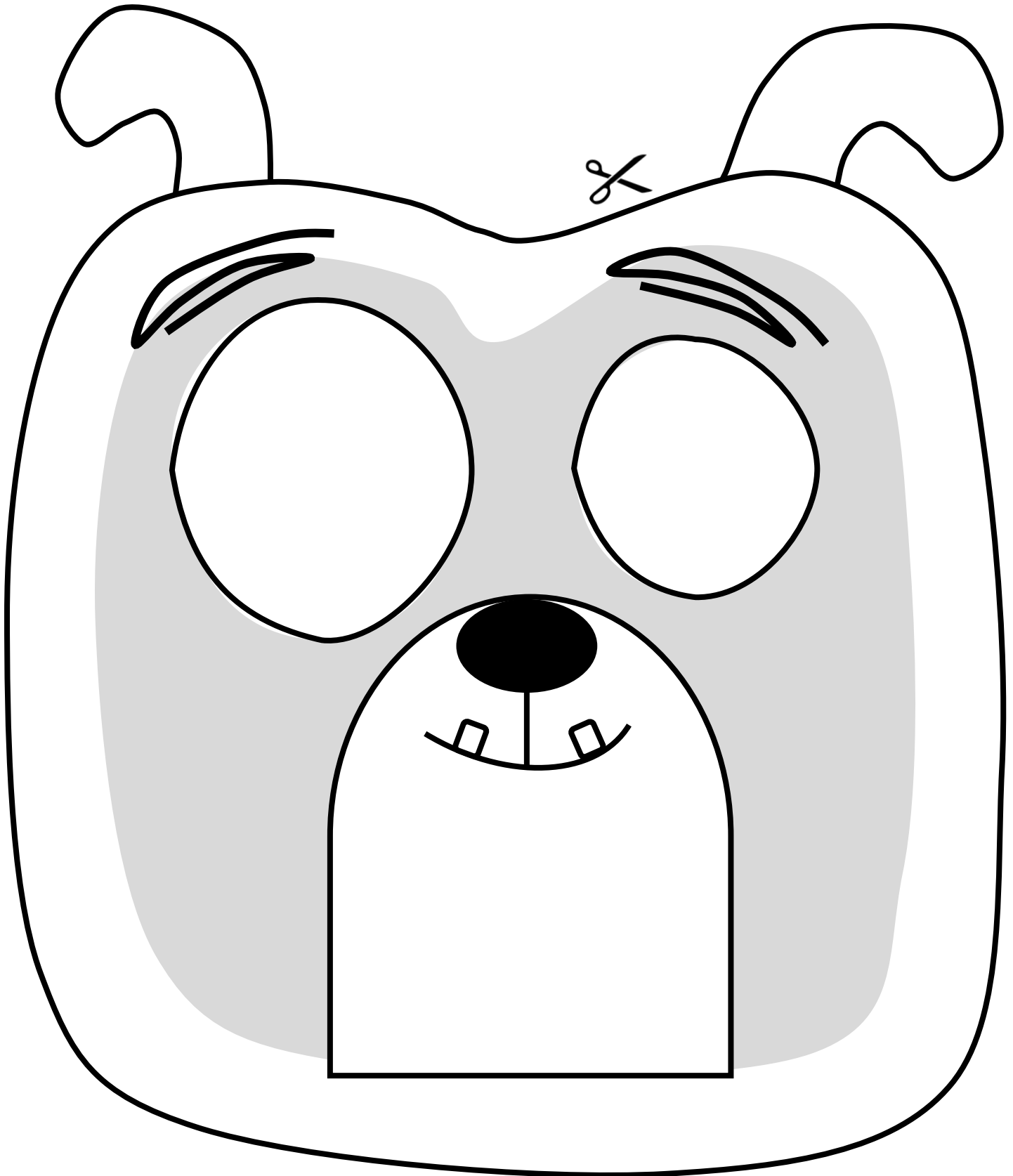

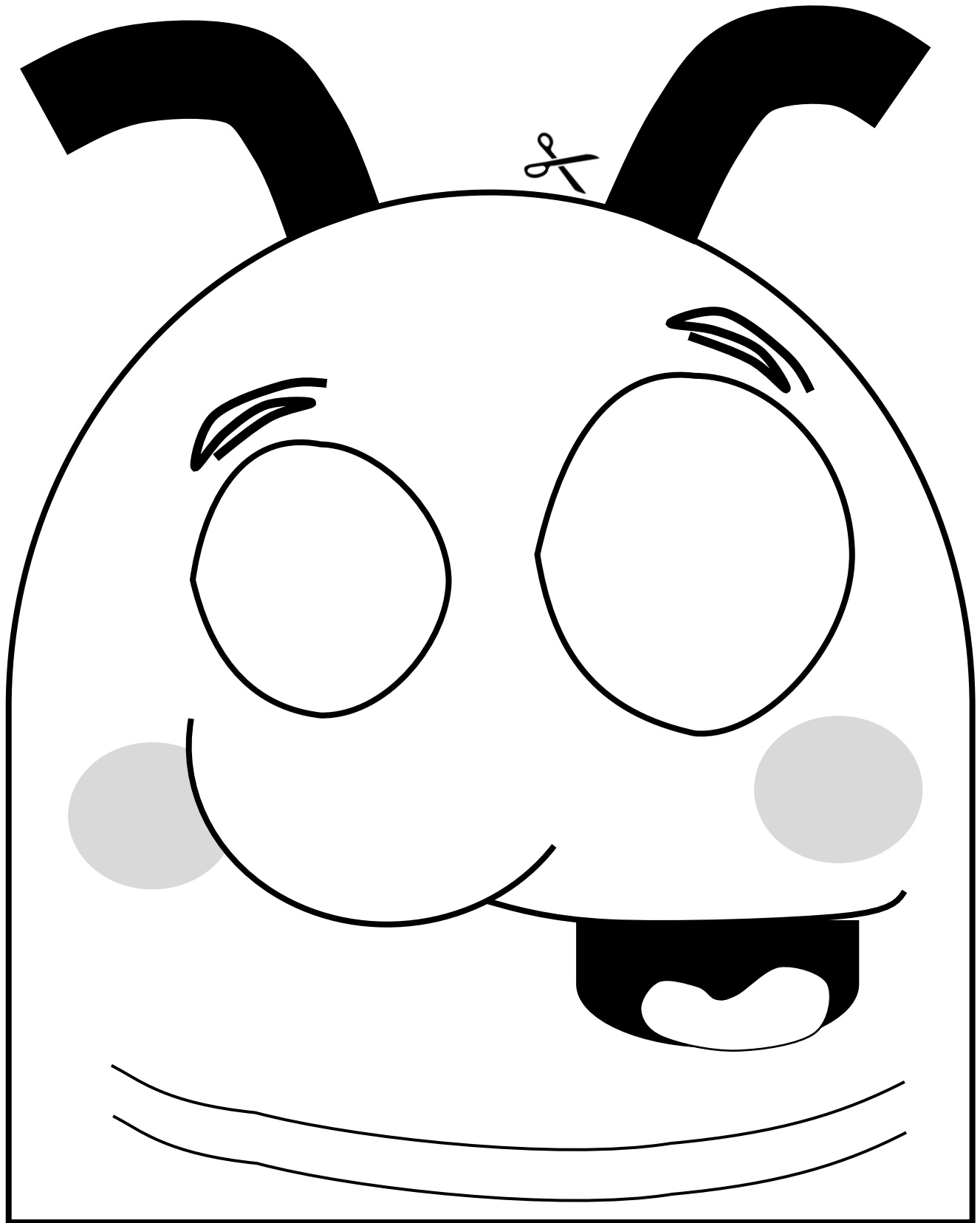
Print on white paper and decorate. Cut the outline of the mask apart, including two eye holes. Then, use tape to secure the mask to a popsicle stick.
